

Notification on Memberships, Internships & the 2021 Handbook on AI and International Law

In line with the by-laws of the Indian Society of Artificial Intelligence and Law, the Board of Trustees has approved this notification on the basis of multiple requests received by our office-bearers on:

- How to become a member of ISAIL
- How to pursue internships under ISAIL
- How to purchase the 2021 Handbook on AI and International Law

This notification states as follows:

Membership Requirements and the Process

Only the following are eligible to become the ordinary members of the Indian Society of Artificial Intelligence and Law:

- Indian or Foreign Nationals, who possess a government identification document
- Professionals and scholars in the fields of law, technology and public policy

The membership process is simple. The applicant is required to submit their recent curriculum vitae/contact details at vligta@indicpacific.com.

The Vidhitsu Law Institute of Global and Technology Affairs, also known as VLiGTA shall be the facilitator of the applications. Based on the recommendations of VLiGTA and our office bearers, we may request the concerned applicant to voluntarily submit a government ID proof to verify the applicant's identity for security purposes.

We may accept or reject the membership request in line with the Guidelines on Presence and Activities in Online Groups and Workspaces (isail.in/guidelines) or any other by-laws of the Trust, in line with the laws of the Republic of India.

Once an applicant is permitted to become a member of ISAIL, they are required to submit a one-time registration fee of 500 INR via UPI (indiansocietyai@ybl) and send an email confirming the same. Once we verify the payment, an identification code will be given to the applicant as an ordinary member in the form of an alphanumeric code, which the person can use to verify their ordinary memberships.

The membership may be subject to renewal after a period of 1 year. We do not enable RBI mandates via UPI only to ensure that applicants who are voluntarily interested to become ordinary members of ISAIL, may remain members as they wish.

Internship Application Procedure

Only students of law and public policy, who are pursuing undergraduate and graduate studies in the respective fields of law and public policy, can apply to be recruited as a Research Intern under the Indian Society of Artificial Intelligence and Law.

They can apply for a 4-week/6-week internship via virtual means (remote) which is regulated as per the Research Credibility and Administrative Directive and other guidelines (isail.in/guidelines).

However, the concerned student has to make it clear that no conflict of interest exists. Also, the applicant has to express that they intend to adhere with the guidelines of the Trust.
